Beijing Wanji Education Consulting Co., Ltd has been selected by the Department of Immigration and Multicultural and Indigenous Affairs (DIMIA) to participate in the AL2-4 Student Internet Lodgement Trial which is being conducted in China, India and Thailand.

Pre-visa assessment (PVA) arrangements do not apply to applications lodged through the eVisa facility and a Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) must be available at the time an eVisa application is lodged. Evisa applications may be lodged up to four months (124 days) before course commencement.

We would be grateful for your assistance in issuing CoEs to this education agent. DIMIA would prefer applications with a two-month or longer lead-time.
